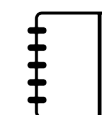

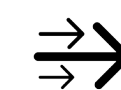

**Healthy Options in 2019** Fee-based services to provide care and enhance your health: The Brain Fitness Club is designed for persons experiencing early memory loss. Members of BFC engage in brain-healthy activities (mental stimulation, light physical exercise and socialization), including one-on-one therapy and individualized programming designed by graduate clinicians from UCF.
